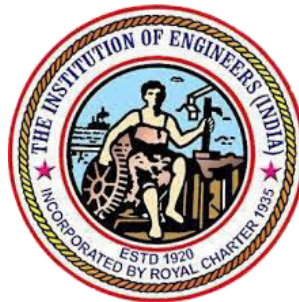

Opinion

We further report that:

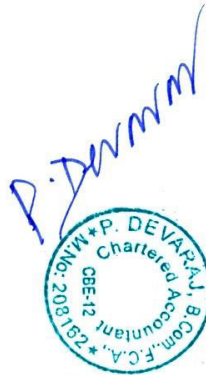

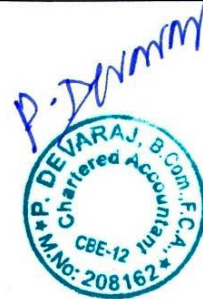
